BROOKLYN'S PLAYGROUND SETS SIGHTS ON PEPSI GRANT

POCATELLO — Valley Pride is asking for the public's help in trying to win a \$50,000 grant from Pepsi Refresh.

"We absolutely dominated the national voting for the earlier \$15,000 grant from KaBOOM! in May," Tim Forhan, Chairperson of Valley Pride said via a prepared statement. "So I'm hoping that in the second part of the month, the community will rally behind voting for the playground in the Pepsi Refresh competition. This \$50,000 would be a huge jump forward for the project."

The playground was making strong headway toward becoming a top 10 contender for the grant. However, the last few days they have slipped two places in the first part of this week.
